Arrival

For parents who will personally accompany their son to Dublin Oak, we will be happy to receive you on **Thursday June 29th from 9 am to 5 pm.**

If your son is travelling alone or in a group to Ireland, we can organize for him to be picked up at Dublin Airport free of charge **between the hours of 9 am to 5 pm. Arrivals outside of these times will incur an extra charge.**

Personal Account

It is advised that you provide your son with approximately €250 for his personal account for expenses for the 4 weeks Summer Camp and €125 for the 2 weeks camp. Any remaining amount at the end of the course, will be reimbursed in cash at his departure. Please note that official group transport to and from Dublin airport is included in the fees. However, if your son travels outside of the official times a taxi fare will be charged to his personal account.

Laundry

A specific student laundry number will be assigned to your son and sent in his acceptance letter and welcome package. Please make sure you mark your son's personal belongings with this number on a visible place (collar for shirts, waist for trousers, ankle for socks...) The students in Dublin Oak Academy are provided laundry service, this number will ensure his clothes are returned to him in a timely

Manner. Laundry will be picked up daily and returned within 24 hours. All clothes must be both machine washable and tumble dryable. Please use sewed in labels if possible.

Departure

For parents who will personally pick up their son from the summer camp, we will be happy to receive you on **Thursday, July 27th 2023 between 10 am and 1 pm.** If your son is departing alone or in a group, we will organize for him to be taken to Dublin Airport free of charge **between the hours of 9 am to 5 pm. Departures outside of these times will incur an extra charge.**

Phone Calls

Phone calls with your son will be on Wednesday and Sunday from **7.30pm to 8.00pm (Irish time).**

Medical*

Any specific medical requests should be sent in writing on application. Should your son need to be taken to see any doctor throughout his stay, these visits will be charged to his personal account.

***Please make sure you send all relevant information about your son's known allergies (especially food allergies) or injuries, if any, well in advance.**

- 1 pair of sandals (pool shoes or flip flops)

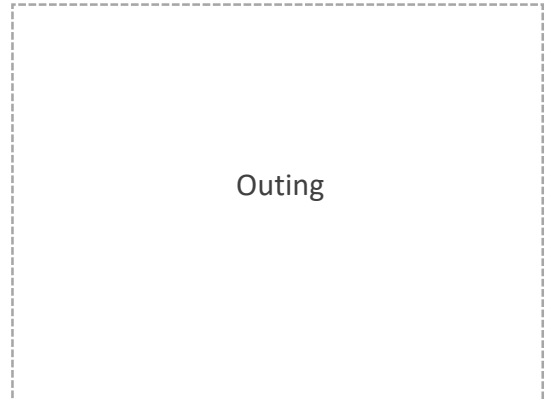
